Q1. Of what tribe was Ehud?

Judges 3:15 (KJV) — 'Ehud the son of Gera, a Benjamite.' (Judges 3:15, KJV)

Q2. What notable trait did Ehud have?

Answer: B. He was left-handed

Judges 3:15 (KJV) — 'a man lefthanded.' (Judges 3:15, KJV)

Q3. Which king of Moab oppressed Israel?

Answer: B. Eglon

Judges 3:14 (KJV) — 'the children of Israel served Eglon the king of Moab.' (Judges 3:14, KJV)

Q4. How long had Israel served Eglon?

Answer: B. 18 years

Judges 3:14 (KJV) — 'eighteen years.' (Judges 3:14, KJV)

Q5. Where did Ehud hide his dagger?

Answer: A. Under his coat on his right thigh

Judges 3:16 (KJV) — 'did gird it under his raiment upon his right thigh.' (Judges 3:16, KJV)

Q6. What did Ehud say he had for the king?

Answer: B. A secret errand from God

Judges 3:20 (KJV) — 'I have a message from God unto thee.' (Judges 3:20, KJV)

Q7. Describe Eglon's appearance.

Answer: B. A very fat man

Judges 3:17 (KJV) — 'Eglon was a very fat man.' (Judges 3:17, KJV)

Q8. Where did Ehud thrust the dagger?

Answer: B. Into his belly

Judges 3:21 (KJV) — 'thrust it into his belly.' (Judges 3:21, KJV)

Q9. Where did Ehud blow a trumpet to gather Israel?

Answer: B. Mount Ephraim

Judges 3:27 (KJV) — 'he blew a trumpet in the mountain of Ephraim.' (Judges 3:27, KJV)

Q10. How long did the land have rest after Ehud?

Answer: C. 80 years

Judges 3:30 (KJV) — 'the land had rest fourscore years.' (Judges 3:30, KJV)
