## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1. Who was Enoch's father?**

**Answer:** A. Jared

And Jared lived an hundred sixty and two years, and begat Enoch. (Genesis 5:18, KJV)

**Q2. What was Enoch's son's name?**

**Answer:** B. Methuselah

And Enoch lived sixty and five years, and begat Methuselah. (Genesis 5:21, KJV)

**Q3. How long did Enoch walk with God?**

**Answer:** C. Three hundred years

And Enoch walked with God after he begat Methuselah three hundred years. (Genesis 5:22, KJV)

**Q4. How old was Enoch when God took him?**

**Answer:** A. Three hundred sixty and five years

And all the days of Enoch were three hundred sixty and five years. (Genesis 5:23, KJV)

**Q5. What happened to Enoch at the end of his life?**

**Answer:** B. He was translated; God took him

And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him. (Genesis 5:24, KJV)

**Q6. What did Enoch have before his translation?**

**Answer:** A. A testimony, that he pleased God

By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God. (Hebrews 11:5, KJV)

**Q7. According to Hebrews 11:6, without what is it impossible to please God?**

**Answer:** B. Faith

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. (Hebrews 11:6, KJV)

**Q8. What did Enoch prophesy about?**

**Answer:** B. The coming of the Lord with ten thousands of his saints

And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints. (Jude 1:14, KJV)

**Q9. In which of Adam's two lineages is Enoch found?**

**Answer:** B. Seth's line to Noah

Enoch is in the godly line of Seth, the seventh from Adam, through whom Noah came. (Genesis 5, KJV)

**Q10. How is Enoch's walk with God described?**

**Answer:** B. Continuous and faithful — he walked with God

And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him. Twice Genesis says Enoch walked with God, emphasising a life of fellowship. (Genesis 5:24, KJV)
