As ye also learned of Epaphras our dear fellowservant, who is for you a faithful minister of Christ. (Colossians 1:7) (Colossians 1:7, KJV)

Q2. Of what city was Epaphras?

Answer: A. Colosse

Epaphras, who is one of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you. (Colossians 4:12) (Colossians 4:12, KJV)

Q3. What was Epaphras to the Colossians?

Answer: A. A faithful minister of Christ for them

...Epaphras... who is for you a faithful minister of Christ. (Colossians 1:7) (Colossians 1:7, KJV)

Q4. What did Epaphras declare to Paul?

Answer: A. Your love in the Spirit

The Greek behind 'labouring fervently' (agonizomenos) means to strive or agonize — the same root as 'agony' — pictures wrestling intercession. (Colossians 4:12) (Colossians 4:12, KJV)
