## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1.** According to the first chapter, in whom do we have redemption through his blood and the forgiveness of sins?

**Answer:** B. The beloved

Ephesians 1:6-7 states we are accepted in the beloved, in whom we have redemption. (Ephesians 1:7, KJV)

**Q2.** By what are we saved through faith, and that not of ourselves?

**Answer:** C. Grace

For by grace are ye saved through faith; it is the gift of God. (Ephesians 2:8, KJV)

**Q3.** Paul describes himself as being 'less than the least of all' what?

**Answer:** B. Saints

Paul humbles himself, saying this grace was given to preach among the Gentiles. (Ephesians 3:8, KJV)

**Q4.** How many 'lords', 'faiths', and 'baptisms' does Paul list in chapter 4?

**Answer:** A. One

The scripture emphasizes unity: 'One Lord, one faith, one baptism'. (Ephesians 4:5, KJV)

**Q5.** What should not 'let the sun go down upon'?

**Answer:** C. Your wrath

The text advises: 'Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath'. (Ephesians 4:26, KJV)

**Q6.** Followers are told to 'walk in love' as who also hath loved us?

**Answer:** B. Christ

We are told to walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us and given himself for us. (Ephesians 5:2, KJV)

**Q7.** To what does Paul compare the relationship between a husband and wife?

Paul speaks concerning Christ and the church as the model for marriage. (Ephesians 5:32, KJV)

**Q8.** Which is the first commandment with promise?

**Answer:** C. Honour thy father and mother

Honouring parents is noted as the first commandment with a specific promise. (Ephesians 6:2, KJV)

**Q9.** What is the 'sword of the Spirit' in the whole armour of God?

**Answer:** A. The word of God

The scripture explicitly identifies the sword of the Spirit as the word of God. (Ephesians 6:17, KJV)

**Q10.** Against what do we wrestle, according to Ephesians 6:12?

**Answer:** B. Principalities and powers

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities and powers. (Ephesians 6:12, KJV)
