Q1. In what city did this take place?

Answer: B. Troas

Acts 20:6-7 (KJV) — they came to Troas and abode seven days. (Acts 20:7, KJV)

Q2. On what day of the week were they gathered?

Answer: B. First day of the week

Acts 20:7 (KJV) — 'upon the first day of the week.' (Acts 20:7, KJV)

Q3. For what purpose were they gathered?

Answer: B. To break bread

Acts 20:7 (KJV) — 'the disciples came together to break bread.' (Acts 20:7, KJV)

Q4. Until what hour did Paul preach?

Answer: B. Midnight

Acts 20:7 (KJV) — 'continued his speech until midnight.' (Acts 20:7, KJV)

Q5. Where was Eutychus sitting?

Answer: B. In a window

Acts 20:9 (KJV) — 'sat in a window a certain young man named Eutychus.' (Acts 20:9, KJV)

Q6. From what loft did Eutychus fall?

Answer: C. Third

Acts 20:9 (KJV) — 'fell down from the third loft.' (Acts 20:9, KJV)

Q7. How was he found?

Answer: B. Taken up dead

Acts 20:9 (KJV) — 'was taken up dead.' (Acts 20:9, KJV)

Q8. What did Paul do?

Answer: B. Fell on him and embraced him

Acts 20:10 (KJV) — 'fell on him, and embracing him.' (Acts 20:10, KJV)

Q9. What did Paul say?

Answer: B. Trouble not yourselves; his life is in him

Acts 20:10 (KJV) — 'Trouble not yourselves; for his life is in him.' (Acts 20:10, KJV)

Q10. What comfort was given afterward?

Answer: B. They brought the young man alive

Acts 20:12 (KJV) — 'they brought the young man alive, and were not a little comforted.' (Acts 20:12, KJV)
