Acts 23:24 (KJV) — Paul was brought 'safe unto Felix the governor.' (Acts 23:24, KJV)

Q2. In what city did Felix reside?

Answer: B. Caesarea

Acts 23:33 (KJV) — 'when they came to Caesarea, and delivered the epistle to the governor.' (Acts 23:33, KJV)

Q3. Who was Felix's wife?

Answer: B. Drusilla

Acts 24:24 (KJV) — 'his wife Drusilla, which was a Jewess.' (Acts 24:24, KJV)

Q4. Who was the orator who accused Paul before Felix?

Answer: A. Tertullus

Acts 24:1 (KJV) — 'a certain orator named Tertullus.' (Acts 24:1, KJV)

Q5. Of what three things did Paul reason before Felix?

Answer: B. Righteousness, temperance, and judgment to come

Acts 24:25 (KJV) — 'righteousness, temperance, and judgment to come.' (Acts 24:25, KJV)

Q6. What did Felix do as Paul reasoned?

Answer: B. Trembled

Acts 24:25 (KJV) — 'Felix trembled.' (Acts 24:25, KJV)

Q7. What did Felix say to Paul?

Answer: B. Go thy way for this time; when I have a convenient season I will call for thee

Acts 24:25 (KJV). (Acts 24:25, KJV)

Q8. What did Felix hope to be given him?

Answer: A. A bribe (money)

Acts 24:26 (KJV) — 'He hoped also that money should have been given him of Paul.' (Acts 24:26, KJV)

Q9. How long was Paul left bound under Felix?

Answer: B. Two years

Acts 24:27 (KJV) — 'after two years Porcius Festus came into Felix' room.' (Acts 24:27, KJV)

Q10. Why did Felix leave Paul bound?

Answer: A. To please the Jews

Acts 24:27 (KJV) — 'Felix, willing to shew the Jews a pleasure, left Paul bound.' (Acts 24:27, KJV)
