Q1. From which city did Goliath come?

Answer: C. Gath

And there went out a champion out of the camp of the Philistines, named Goliath, of Gath. (1 Samuel 17:4) (1 Samuel 17:4, KJV)

Q2. How tall was Goliath?

Answer: C. Six cubits and a span

And his height was six cubits and a span. (1 Samuel 17:4) (1 Samuel 17:4, KJV)

Q3. What was the weight of Goliath's coat of mail?

Answer: B. Five thousand shekels

And he had an helmet of brass upon his head, and he was armed with a coat of mail; and the weight of the coat was five thousand shekels of brass. (1 Samuel 17:5) (1 Samuel 17:5, KJV)

Q4. What were Goliath's greaves made of?

Answer: C. Brass

And he had greaves of brass upon his legs, and a target of brass between his shoulders. (1 Samuel 17:6) (1 Samuel 17:6, KJV)

Q5. What was the weight of the head of Goliath's spear?

Answer: C. Six hundred shekels

And the staff of his spear was like a weaver's beam; and his spear's head weighed six hundred shekels of iron. (1 Samuel 17:7) (1 Samuel 17:7, KJV)

Q6. Who carried Goliath's shield?

Answer: B. A young man

And one bearing a shield went before him. (1 Samuel 17:7) (1 Samuel 17:7, KJV)

Q7. How long did Goliath challenge Israel each day?

Answer: C. Forty days

And the Philistine drew near morning and evening, and presented himself forty days. (1 Samuel 17:16) (1 Samuel 17:16, KJV)

Q8. What did Goliath say would happen if he killed his opponent?

Answer: B. Israel would become servants to the Philistines

If he be able to fight with me, and to kill me, then will we be your servants. (1 Samuel 17:9) (1 Samuel 17:9, KJV)

Q9. What did David take from the brook?

Answer: B. Five smooth stones

And he took his staff in his hand, and chose him five smooth stones out of the brook. (1 Samuel 17:40) (1 Samuel 17:40, KJV)

Q10. Where did David strike Goliath with the stone?

Answer: B. His forehead

And the stone sunk into his forehead. (1 Samuel 17:49) (1 Samuel 17:49, KJV)
