Q1. How are we saved, according to Ephesians 2:8?

Answer: B. By grace through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. (Ephesians 2:8, KJV)

Q2. What does Romans 3:23 say about all people?

Answer: A. All have sinned, and come short of the glory of God

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus. (Romans 3:23, KJV)

Q3. What did Jesus say about his grace to Paul?

Answer: A. My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness

And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. (2 Corinthians 12:9, KJV)

Q4. Where sin abounded, what did grace do?
