Q1. In the second year of which king did the word of the LORD come by Haggai the prophet?

Answer: B. Darius

The prophecy began in the second year of Darius the king. (Haggai 1:1, KJV)

Q2. To which governor of Judah was the word of the LORD first addressed?

Answer: C. Zerubbabel

The word was sent to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah. (Haggai 1:1, KJV)

Q3. What did the people say regarding the timing of rebuilding the LORD's house?

Answer: A. The time is not come

The people said, 'The time is not come, the time that the LORD's house should be built.' (Haggai 1:2, KJV)

Q4. What phrase does the LORD of hosts use twice in the first chapter to urge the people to reflection?

Answer: B. Consider your ways

The LORD twice commands the people to 'Consider your ways.' (Haggai 1:5, KJV)

Q5. According to Haggai 1:6, what happened to the person who earned wages?

Answer: C. He put them into a bag with holes

He that earneth wages earneth wages to put it into a bag with holes. (Haggai 1:6, KJV)

Q6. Where did the LORD tell the people to go to bring wood for the house?

Answer: B. To the mountain

The LORD commanded them to 'Go up to the mountain, and bring wood.' (Haggai 1:8, KJV)

Q7. The LORD said the glory of this latter house shall be greater than what?

Answer: B. The former

The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former. (Haggai 2:9, KJV)

Q8. What did the LORD promise to give in 'this place' (the temple)?

Answer: B. Peace

The LORD of hosts promised, 'and in this place will I give peace.' (Haggai 2:9, KJV)

Q9. The LORD asked the priests if holy flesh in the skirt of a garment makes other food holy; what was their answer?

Answer: B. No

The priests answered and said, 'No.' (Haggai 2:12, KJV)

Q10. The LORD promised to make Zerubbabel like what object?

Answer: B. A signet

The LORD said He would make Zerubbabel 'as a signet.' (Haggai 2:23, KJV)
