Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. Who was Hannah's husband?

Answer: B. Elkanah

Now there was a certain man of Ramathaimzophim, of mount Ephraim, and his name was Elkanah. (1 Samuel 1:1, KJV)

Q2. What was Hannah's rival wife's name?

Answer: A. Peninnah

And he had two wives; the name of the one was Hannah, and the name of the other Peninnah. (1 Samuel 1:2, KJV)

Q3. Why was Hannah sorrowful?

Answer: A. Because she had no children, and Peninnah provoked her

But Hannah had no children. And her adversary also provoked her sore, for to make her fret, because the LORD had shut up her womb. (1 Samuel 1:5, KJV)

Q4. Where did Hannah go to pray?

Answer: B. To the house of the LORD in Shiloh

Now Hannah, she spake in her heart; only her lips moved, but her voice was not heard: therefore Eli thought she had been drunken. (1 Samuel 1:13, KJV)

Q5. What did the priest Eli initially think Hannah was?

Answer: B. Drunken

And Eli said unto her, How long wilt thou be drunken? put away thy wine from thee. (1 Samuel 1:14, KJV)

Q6. What did Hannah vow to do if God gave her a son?

Answer: B. Give him to the LORD all the days of his life, and no razor shall come upon his head

O LORD of hosts, if thou wilt indeed look on the affliction of thine handmaid... but wilt give unto thine handmaid a man child, then I will give him unto the LORD all the days of his life, and there shall no razor come upon his head. (1 Samuel 1:11, KJV)

Q7. What did Hannah name her son?

Answer: B. Samuel

Wherefore it came to pass, when the time was come about after Hannah had conceived, that she bare a son, and called his name Samuel, saying, Because I have asked him of the LORD. (1 Samuel 1:20, KJV)

Q8. How old was Samuel when Hannah brought him to the house of the LORD?

Answer: B. About five or six, when weaned

And when she had weaned him, she took him up with her... and brought him unto the house of the LORD in Shiloh: and the child was young. (1 Samuel 1:24, KJV)

Q9. What did Hannah bring Samuel to Shiloh each year?

Answer: B. A little ephod and a bullock, flour, and wine

Moreover his mother made him a little coat, and brought it to him from year to year, when she came up with her husband to offer the yearly sacrifice. (1 Samuel 2:19, KJV)

Q10. What is Hannah's prayer in 1 Samuel 2 known as?

Answer: A. The prayer of Hannah — a psalm of praise exalting the LORD

And Hannah prayed, and said, My heart rejoiceth in the LORD, mine horn is exalted in the LORD: my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because I rejoice in thy salvation. (1 Samuel 2:1, KJV)
