Q1. How old was Methuselah when he died?

Answer: C. 969

And all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred sixty and nine years. (Genesis 5:27, KJV)

Q2. Which minor prophet's name means 'My messenger'?

Answer: B. Malachi

Malachi closes the Old Testament canon. (Malachi 1:1, KJV)

Q3. How many years did the Israelites wander in the wilderness?

Answer: B. 40

Forty years for the unbelief that turned them back from Canaan. (Numbers 14:33, KJV)

Q4. Who was Paul's companion called 'the beloved physician'?

Answer: C. Luke

Luke, the beloved physician, and Demas, greet you. (Colossians 4:14, KJV)

Q5. Which king saw a hand writing on the wall?

Answer: C. Belshazzar

Mene, Mene, Tekel, Upharsin — read by Daniel for Belshazzar. (Daniel 5, KJV)

Q6. How many days was Jonah in the belly of the great fish?

Answer: B. 3

Three days and three nights, a sign of the Son of man. (Jonah 1:17, KJV)

Q7. Who was high priest the year Jesus was crucified?

Answer: B. Caiaphas

Caiaphas, being the high priest that same year. (John 18:13, KJV)

Q8. What is the sixth book of the New Testament?

Answer: B. Romans

Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, Acts, Romans.

Q9. Whose staff budded as a sign from God?

Answer: B. Aaron's

Aaron's rod budded and brought forth almonds. (Numbers 17:8, KJV)

Q10. Which book of the Bible never mentions God by name?

Answer: B. Esther

The book of Esther tells of God's hidden providence without naming Him.
