Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. What does Isaiah 53:5 say about Christ's stripes?

Answer: A. With his stripes we are healed

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. (Isaiah 53:5, KJV)

Q2. What did the woman with the issue of blood do?

Answer: A. She touched the hem of Jesus' garment in faith

And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind him, and touched the hem of his garment: For she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole. (Matthew 9:20, KJV)

Q3. What did Jesus say to the woman with the issue of blood?

Answer: A. Thy faith hath made thee whole

But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour. (Matthew 9:22, KJV)

Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up. (James 5:14, KJV)

Jesus said unto him, Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee... Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house. And he arose, and departed to his house. (Matthew 9:2, KJV)

And, behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou Son of David. (Matthew 20:30, KJV)

Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. And their eyes were opened. (Matthew 9:29, KJV)
