Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. What did Jesus say He went to prepare?

Answer: A. A place for you in my Father's house

In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. (John 14:2, KJV)

Q2. What did John see come down from God?

Answer: A. The holy city, new Jerusalem

And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (Revelation 21:2, KJV)

Q3. What shall God wipe away in heaven?

Answer: A. All tears from their eyes

And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. (Revelation 21:4, KJV)

Q4. What did Paul say of the things God hath prepared?

Answer: A. Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard... the things which God hath prepared for them that love him

But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. (1 Corinthians 2:9, KJV)

For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ. (Philippians 3:20, KJV)

Q8. What did John behold round about the throne?

After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb. (Revelation 7:9, KJV)

Q9. How are the streets of the holy city described?

Answer: A. Pure gold, as it were transparent glass

And the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass. (Revelation 21:21, KJV)

Q10. What shall they sing before the throne?

Answer: A. Worthy is the Lamb that was slain

Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing. (Revelation 5:12, KJV)
