Q1. Who was carried to Abraham's bosom in Luke 16?

Answer: A. Lazarus the beggar

And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom. (Luke 16:22, KJV)

Q2. Where did the rich man lift up his eyes?

Answer: A. In hell, being in torments

And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. (Luke 16:23, KJV)

Q3. What separates the rich man from Abraham?

Answer: A. A great gulf fixed

And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot. (Luke 16:26, KJV)

Q4. How does Jesus describe hell in Mark 9?

Answer: A. Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched

Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched. (Mark 9:44, KJV)

Q5. For whom was everlasting fire prepared?

Answer: A. The devil and his angels

Q6. What is the final destination of the devil per Revelation 20?

And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. (Revelation 20:15, KJV)

Q9. Whom should we fear according to Matthew 10:28?

Answer: A. Him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell

And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. (Matthew 10:28, KJV)

Q10. What did the rich man ask be sent to his brethren?

Answer: A. Lazarus, lest they also come into this place of torment

Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house: For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment. (Luke 16:27, KJV)
