Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee. (Genesis 12:1) (Genesis 12:1, KJV)

Q2. What does Psalm 107:23-24 describe about those who go down to the sea?

Answer: A. They see the works of the LORD, and his wonders in the deep

They that go down to the sea in ships, that do business in great waters; These see the works of the LORD, and his wonders in the deep. (Psalm 107:23-24) (Psalms 107:23, KJV)

Q3. What does Proverbs 3:5-6 say about trusting the LORD?

Answer: A. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths

Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. (Proverbs 3:5-6) (Proverbs 3:5, KJV)

Q4. What does Isaiah 41:10 say about fearing not?

Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest. (Joshua 1:9) (Joshua 1:9, KJV)

Q9. What does Psalm 19:1-4 say the heavens declare?

Answer: A. The glory of God; and their line is gone out through all the earth

The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork. Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge. There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard. Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. (Psalm 19:1-4) (Psalms 19:1, KJV)

Q10. What does Romans 10:18 say about hearing the word?
