Q1. What did God command Adam and Eve to do with the earth?

And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth. (Genesis 1:28) (Genesis 1:28, KJV)

Q2. What did God see after creating everything?

Answer: A. That it was very good

And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. (Genesis 1:31) (Genesis 1:31, KJV)

Q3. What did God put Adam in the garden to do?

Answer: A. To dress it and to keep it

And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it. (Genesis 2:15) (Genesis 2:15, KJV)

Q4. What does Psalm 24:1 declare?

While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease. (Genesis 8:22) (Genesis 8:22, KJV)
