The hoary head is a crown of glory, if it be found in the way of righteousness. (Proverbs 16:31) (Proverbs 16:31, KJV)

Q2. What is the glory of young men, and of old men?

Answer: A. The glory of young men is their strength: and the beauty of old men is the gray head

The glory of young men is their strength: and the beauty of old men is the gray head. (Proverbs 20:29) (Proverbs 20:29, KJV)

Q3. Whom did Paul commend for unfeigned faith first dwelling in his grandmother?

Now also when I am old and grayheaded, O God, forsake me not; until I have shewed thy strength unto this generation, and thy power to every one that is to come. (Psalm 71:18) (Psalms 71:18, KJV)

Q9. How old was Sarah when Isaac was born?

And Sarah said, God hath made me to laugh, so that all that hear will laugh with me... For I have born him a son in his old age. (Genesis 21:6-7) — Abraham was 100 and Sarah was 90. (Genesis 17:17, KJV)
