Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass. (Matthew 21:5) (Matthew 21:5, KJV)

Q2. What did the multitude cry as Jesus entered Jerusalem?

Answer: A. Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest

And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest. (Matthew 21:9) (Matthew 21:9, KJV)

Q3. What did Jesus do in the temple?

Answer: A. Overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves

And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves. (Matthew 21:12) (Matthew 21:12, KJV)

Q4. What did Jesus institute at the Last Supper?

Answer: A. The bread, This is my body; and the cup, This is my blood of the new testament

And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body. Q7. Who betrayed Jesus with a kiss?

Answer: A. Judas Iscariot

Now he that betrayed him gave them a sign, saying, Whomsoever I shall kiss, that same is he: hold him fast. And forthwith he came to Jesus, and said, Hail, master; and kissed him. (Matthew 26:48-49) (Matthew 26:48, KJV)

Q8. What did the people cry when Pilate asked what to do with Jesus?
