If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed. (John 8:36) (John 8:36, KJV)

Q2. What does Galatians 5:1 call believers to stand fast in?

Answer: A. The liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free

Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. (Galatians 5:1) (Galatians 5:1, KJV)

Q3. What does 2 Corinthians 3:17 say where the Spirit of the Lord is?

Answer: A. There is liberty

Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. (2 Corinthians 3:17) (2 Corinthians 3:17, KJV)

Q4. What does Romans 13:1 say about powers?

Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. (Romans 13:1) (Romans 13:1, KJV)

As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God. (1 Peter 2:16) (1 Peter 2:16, KJV)

Q6. What does Leviticus 25:10 say about the jubilee?

And ye shall hallow the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land unto all the inhabitants thereof: it shall be a jubilee unto you; and ye shall return every man unto his possession, and ye shall return every man unto his family. (Leviticus 25:10) (Leviticus 25:10, KJV)

Q7. What did Jesus read in the synagogue at Nazareth about liberty?

Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD; and the people whom he hath chosen for his own inheritance. (Psalm 33:12) (Psalms 33:12, KJV)

Q10. What does Romans 8:21 say creation itself shall be delivered into?

Answer: A. The glorious liberty of the children of God

Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. (Romans 8:21) (Romans 8:21, KJV)
