**Q1. What does Galatians 5:1 say Christ has made us free for?**

**Answer:** A. For freedom: stand fast therefore, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage

Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. (Galatians 5:1) (Galatians 5:1, KJV)

**Q2. What does John 8:36 say about the Son making free?**

**Answer:** A. If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed

If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed. (John 8:36) (John 8:36, KJV)

**Q3. What does Isaiah 61:1 say the Messiah is sent to do?**

**Answer:** A. To preach good tidings unto the meek; to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me... to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound. (Isaiah 61:1) (Isaiah 61:1, KJV)

**Q4. What does Exodus 20:2 say the LORD did for Israel?**

**Answer:** A. Brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage

I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. (Exodus 20:2) (Exodus 20:2, KJV)

**Q5. What does Leviticus 25:10 say to proclaim?**

**Answer:** A. Liberty throughout all the land unto all the inhabitants thereof

And ye shall hallow the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land unto all the inhabitants thereof: it shall be a jubilee unto you. (Leviticus 25:10) (Leviticus 25:10, KJV)

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised. (Luke 4:18) (Luke 4:18, KJV)

**Q8. What does James 1:25 call the perfect law of liberty?**

**Answer:** A. The law that brings blessing to the doer

But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed. (James 1:25) (James 1:25, KJV)

**Q9. What does Romans 8:21 say creation shall be delivered into?**

**Answer:** A. The glorious liberty of the children of God

Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. (Romans 8:21) (Romans 8:21, KJV)

**Q10.** What does 2 Corinthians 3:17 say where the Spirit of the Lord is?

**Answer:** A. There is liberty

Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. (2 Corinthians 3:17) (2 Corinthians 3:17, KJV)
