Q1. How many days did Jesus fast in the wilderness?

Answer: A. Forty days and forty nights

Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungred. (Matthew 4:1-2) (Matthew 4:2, KJV)

Q2. What did Jesus use to answer each temptation?

Answer: A. It is written

But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. (Matthew 4:4) (Matthew 4:4, KJV)

Q3. What does Deuteronomy 8:3 say man shall not live by?

Answer: A. Bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD

And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live. For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. (Hebrews 4:15) (Hebrews 4:15, KJV)

Answer: A. Me, even as I also am of Christ

Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ. (1 Corinthians 11:1) (1 Corinthians 11:1, KJV)
