**Q1.** In which month was the Feast of Trumpets to be kept?

**Answer:** A. The seventh month, in the first day of the month

Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation. (Leviticus 23:24) (Leviticus 23:24, KJV)

**Q2.** What was the day to be?

**Answer:** A. A memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation

...shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation. (Leviticus 23:24) (Leviticus 23:24, KJV)

**Q3.** What were they to do no servile work on?

**Answer:** A. The Feast of Trumpets

Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD. (Leviticus 23:25) (Leviticus 23:25, KJV)

**Q4.** What does Numbers 29 call the day?

**Answer:** A. A day of blowing the trumpets

And in the seventh month, on the first day of the month, ye shall have an holy convocation... it is a day of blowing the trumpets unto you. (Numbers 29:1) (Numbers 29:1, KJV)

**Q5.** What did Ezra read to the people on this day?

And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation... upon the first day of the seventh month. (Nehemiah 8:2) (Nehemiah 8:2, KJV)

**Q6.** What did Nehemiah tell the people about this day?

This day is holy unto the LORD your God; mourn not, nor weep. For all the people wept, when they heard the words of the law. (Nehemiah 8:9) (Nehemiah 8:9, KJV)

**Q7.** What was the joy of the LORD called?

**Answer:** A. Your strength

Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet... for the joy of the LORD is your strength. (Nehemiah 8:10) (Nehemiah 8:10, KJV)

**Q8.** What did the trumpet announce in Israel?

**Answer:** A. Solemn feasts, war, and the Lord's appointed seasons

Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months, ye shall blow with the trumpets. (Numbers 10:10) (Numbers 10:10, KJV)

**Q9.** What shall sound at the resurrection of the saints?

**Answer:** A. The trump of God

For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first. (1 Thessalonians 4:16) (1 Thessalonians 4:16, KJV)

**Q10.** At what trump shall we be changed?

**Answer:** A. The last trump

In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. (1 Corinthians 15:52) (1 Corinthians 15:52, KJV)
