Q1. What kind of offering in Leviticus expressed gratitude?

Answer: C. Thank offering / sacrifice of thanksgiving

The sacrifice of thanksgiving... offer it of thy own free will. (Leviticus 22:29, KJV)

Q2. Complete: 'O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is ____'

Answer: B. Good

O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever. (Psalms 107:1, KJV)

Q3. How does Psalm 100 say we should enter His gates?

Answer: B. With joy and gladness

Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise. (Psalms 100:4, KJV)

Q4. Who led Israel in a song of thanksgiving after crossing the Red Sea?

Answer: B. Moses

Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD. (Exodus 15:1, KJV)

Q5. Which king appointed singers to give thanks as the temple was dedicated?

Answer: B. Solomon

Solomon... offered... sacrifices of peace offerings... the priests... and the Levites... stood to praise the LORD. (2 Chronicles 7:6, KJV)

Q6. What did Jesus give thanks for before feeding the five thousand?

Jesus took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed them. (Luke 9:16, KJV)

Q7. How many of the ten lepers returned to give thanks?

There are not found that returned to give glory to God, save this stranger. (Luke 17:18, KJV)

Q8. What does Paul say is the will of God in Christ Jesus?

Answer: B. In every thing give thanks

In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. (1 Thessalonians 5:18, KJV)

Q9. What should we do with thanksgiving, according to Philippians?
