Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. In whose name are believers to be baptized?

Answer: A. The Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. (Matthew 28:19) (Matthew 28:19, KJV)

Q2. What three were heard and seen at Jesus' baptism?

Answer: A. The Father's voice, the Son, and the Spirit as a dove

And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water... and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove... And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son. (Matthew 3:16-17) (Matthew 3:16, KJV)

Q3. What is the great Shema declaration?

Answer: A. The LORD our God is one LORD

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD. (Deuteronomy 6:4) (Deuteronomy 6:4, KJV)

Q4. Who said 'Let us make man in our image'?

Answer: A. God

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. (Genesis 1:26) (Genesis 1:26, KJV)

Q5. What three bear record in heaven (1 John 5:7)?

Answer: A. The Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one

For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. (1 John 5:7) (1 John 5:7, KJV)

Q6. How is Jesus called in John 1?

Answer: A. The Word was God

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (John 1:1) (John 1:1, KJV)

Q7. What did Peter say Ananias had lied to?

Answer: A. The Holy Ghost... thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God

Why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost... thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God. (Acts 5:3-4) — equating the Holy Ghost with God. (Acts 5:3, KJV)

Q8. Whose grace, love, and communion does Paul invoke?

Answer: A. The Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen. (2 Corinthians 13:14) (2 Corinthians 13:14, KJV)

Q9. What did Thomas confess to the risen Jesus?

Answer: A. My Lord and my God

And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God. (John 20:28) (John 20:28, KJV)

Q10. Who shall the Comforter be sent by, in John 14?

Answer: A. The Father shall send him in my name

But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things. (John 14:26) (John 14:26, KJV)
