For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. (Hebrews 2:10) (Hebrews 2:10, KJV)

Q2. What did the LORD tell Joshua to be?

Answer: A. Strong and of a good courage

Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest. (Joshua 1:9) (Joshua 1:9, KJV)

Q3. Who was a mighty man of valour from Gath who joined David?
