Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. (Matthew 11:29, KJV)

**Q2. What does Proverbs 16:18 say about pride?**

Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall. (Proverbs 16:18, KJV)

**Q3. What did Jesus do, though He was in the form of God?**
