Q1. If any of you lack wisdom, what does James say he should do?

Answer: B. Ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally

God giveth to all men liberally and upbraideth not. (James 1:5, KJV)

Q2. A double minded man is described as being what in all his ways?

Answer: A. Unstable

The scripture states a double minded man is unstable in all his ways. (James 1:8, KJV)

Q3. Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from whom?

Answer: C. The Father of lights

Gifts come from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness. (James 1:17, KJV)

Q4. James instructs believers to be swift to hear, slow to speak, and slow to what?

Answer: B. Wrath

Man is exhorted to be slow to wrath. (James 1:19, KJV)

Q5. Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this: To visit the fatherless and whom in their affliction?

Answer: D. Widows

Pure religion involves visiting the fatherless and widows. (James 1:27, KJV)

Q6. James argues that faith, if it hath not works, is what?

Answer: B. Dead, being alone

Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. (James 2:17, KJV)

Q7. What small member of the body does James describe as a 'world of iniquity'?

Answer: C. The tongue

The tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity that defileth the whole body. (James 3:6, KJV)

Q8. James says that if we resist the devil, he will do what?

Answer: B. Flee from you

Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. (James 4:7, KJV)

Q9. What does James compare our life to, which appeareth for a little time and then vanisheth away?

Answer: C. A vapour

For what is your life? It is even a vapour. (James 4:14, KJV)

Q10. Who is the Old Testament prophet mentioned as an example of earnest prayer regarding rain?

Answer: B. Elias

Elias (Elijah) prayed earnestly that it might not rain. (James 5:17, KJV)
