Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. Before Jeremiah was formed in the belly, what did the LORD do for him?

Answer: A. He knew him and sanctified him

The LORD told Jeremiah, 'Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee.' (Jeremiah 1:5, KJV)

Q2. What did Jeremiah see in a vision that represented the coming judgment from the north?

Answer: B. A seething pot

Jeremiah saw a seething pot with the face thereof toward the north. (Jeremiah 1:13, KJV)

Q3. The LORD compared the house of Israel to what material in the hands of a craftsman?

Answer: C. Clay in the potter's hand

The LORD said, 'as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are ye in mine hand.' (Jeremiah 18:6, KJV)

Q4. Which king of Judah cut and burned the roll of Jeremiah's prophecy with a penknife?

Answer: C. Jehoiakim

Jehoiakim cut the roll and cast it into the fire that was on the hearth. (Jeremiah 36:23, KJV)

Q5. Where was Jeremiah cast when he was accused of falling away to the Chaldeans?

Answer: B. A dungeon in the house of Jonathan the scribe

The princes were wroth and put Jeremiah in prison in Jonathan's house. (Jeremiah 37:15, KJV)

Q6. Who rescued Jeremiah from the dungeon of Malchiah where he had sunk in the mire?

Answer: A. Ebed-melech the Ethiopian

Ebed-melech took men and drew up Jeremiah with cords out of the dungeon. (Jeremiah 38:12, KJV)

Q7. For how many years did Jeremiah prophesy that the land would serve the king of Babylon?

Answer: C. 70 years

Jeremiah foretold that these nations shall serve the king of Babylon seventy years. (Jeremiah 25:11, KJV)

Q8. What did Jeremiah buy from his cousin Hanameel as a sign that houses and fields would again be possessed?

Answer: B. A field in Anathoth

Jeremiah bought the field that was in Anathoth for seventeen shekels of silver. (Jeremiah 32:9, KJV)

Q9. The LORD promised to make a 'new covenant' with Israel, writing His law where?

Answer: B. In their hearts

The LORD said, 'I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts.' (Jeremiah 31:33, KJV)

Q10. Who was the scribe that wrote the words of Jeremiah's mouth upon a roll of a book?

Answer: B. Baruch

Baruch the son of Neriah wrote from the mouth of Jeremiah all the words of the LORD. (Jeremiah 36:4, KJV)
