Q1. Who was Jethro?

Answer: A. The priest of Midian, Moses' father-in-law

When Jethro, the priest of Midian, Moses' father in law, heard of all that God had done for Moses, and for Israel his people. (Exodus 18:1) (Exodus 18:1, KJV)

Q2. What was Jethro's relationship to Moses?

Answer: A. Father-in-law

Jethro, the priest of Midian, Moses' father in law. (Exodus 18:1) (Exodus 18:1, KJV)

Q3. Whom did Jethro bring to Moses in the wilderness?

And Jethro, Moses' father in law, came with his sons and his wife unto Moses into the wilderness, where he encamped at the mount of God. (Exodus 18:5) (Exodus 18:5, KJV)

Hearken now unto my voice, I will give thee counsel, and God shall be with thee... thou shalt provide out of all the people able men... and let them judge the people at all seasons: And it shall be, that every great matter they shall bring unto thee, but every small matter they shall judge. (Exodus 18:19-22) (Exodus 18:19, KJV)

Q10. How many thousands, hundreds, fifties, and tens did Jethro suggest appointing?

Answer: A. Rulers of thousands, rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens

And let them judge the people at all seasons: and it shall be, that every great matter they shall bring unto thee, but every small matter they shall judge: so shall it be easier for thyself, and they shall bear the burden with thee.
