Q3. How many children did Job have?

Answer: A. Seven sons and three daughters

And his sons went and feasted in their houses, every one his day; and sent and called for their three sisters to eat and to drink with them. (Job 1:4, KJV)

Q4. What did Job's wife say to him in his affliction?

Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? curse God, and die. But he said unto her, Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. Q10. What did God do for Job in the end?

And the LORD turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before... So the LORD blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning. (Job 42:10, KJV)
