Q1. Who was the father of the prophet Joel?

Answer: A. Pethuel

The book begins by identifying Joel as the son of Pethuel. (Joel 1:1, KJV)

Q2. What specific disaster does Joel describe as having laid waste to the vines and barked the fig trees?

Answer: B. A mighty army of locusts

Joel describes a series of locusts that have devoured the land. (Joel 1:4, KJV)

Q3. What are the people commanded to do instead of rending their garments?

Answer: C. Rend their heart

The LORD calls them to 'rend your heart, and not your garments.' (Joel 2:13, KJV)

Q4. Where does the LORD say he will pour out his spirit upon all flesh?

Answer: B. Afterward

The prophecy states, 'And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit.' (Joel 2:28, KJV)

Q5. According to Joel 2:31, what shall the sun be turned into before the great and terrible day of the LORD?

The scripture says 'The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood.' (Joel 2:31, KJV)

Q9. Where is the 'multitudes, multitudes' located in Joel's prophecy?

Answer: A. The valley of decision

Joel 3:14 speaks of 'Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision.' (Joel 3:14, KJV)

Q10. What will flow out of the house of the LORD in the final restoration?

The text says 'a fountain shall come forth of the house of the LORD.' (Joel 3:18, KJV)
