He made him a coat of many colours. (Genesis 37:3, KJV)

Q2. How many brothers did Joseph have?

Answer: B. 11

Joseph had eleven brothers — the twelve sons of Jacob. (Genesis 35:22, KJV)

Q3. For how many pieces of silver was Joseph sold?

Answer: A. 20

And they... sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty pieces of silver. (Genesis 37:28, KJV)

Q4. Whose wife falsely accused Joseph in Egypt?

Answer: B. Potiphar's wife

And it came to pass... that his master's wife cast her eyes upon Joseph. (Genesis 39:7, KJV)

Q5. Whose dreams did Joseph interpret in prison?

Answer: B. The butler and the baker

The chief butler of the king of Egypt and his baker. (Genesis 40:1, KJV)

Q6. What did Pharaoh's seven lean kine and seven thin ears represent?

Answer: B. Seven years of famine

The seven empty ears blasted with the east wind shall be seven years of famine. (Genesis 41:27, KJV)

Q7. How old was Joseph when he stood before Pharaoh?

Answer: B. 30

And Joseph was thirty years old when he stood before Pharaoh. (Genesis 41:46, KJV)

Q8. What position was Joseph given in Egypt?

Answer: C. Second to Pharaoh / governor

Only in the throne will I be greater than thou. (Genesis 41:40, KJV)

And the cup was found in Benjamin's sack. (Genesis 44:12, KJV)
