Q1. How does Jude describe himself at the beginning of his epistle?

Answer: B. The servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James

Jude identifies himself as the servant of Jesus Christ and the brother of James. (Jude 1:1, KJV)

Q2. What was the original topic Jude intended to write about before feeling the need to exhort his readers?

Answer: A. The common salvation

Jude gave all diligence to write of the common salvation before shifting to an exhortation. (Jude 1:3, KJV)

Q3. Which group of people did the Lord destroy after saving them out of the land of Egypt?

Answer: C. Them that believed not

The Lord, having saved the people out of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not. (Jude 1:5, KJV)

Q4. What happened to the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation?

Answer: C. They are reserved in everlasting chains under darkness

These angels are reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day. (Jude 1:6, KJV)

Q5. Which two cities are mentioned as being set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire?

Answer: B. Sodom and Gomorrha

Sodom and Gomorrha are cited as examples of those suffering the vengeance of eternal fire. (Jude 1:7, KJV)

Q6. Who was the archangel that disputed with the devil about the body of Moses?

Answer: C. Michael

Michael the archangel contended with the devil regarding Moses' body. (Jude 1:9, KJV)

Q7. Jude mentions three men when describing the woe of the ungodly: Cain, Core (Korah), and who else?

Answer: A. Balaam

Jude warns of those who ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward. (Jude 1:11, KJV)

Q8. Who was the 'seventh from Adam' that prophesied of the Lord coming with ten thousands of his saints?

Answer: C. Enoch

Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of the Lord's coming to execute judgment. (Jude 1:14, KJV)

Q9. Jude instructs the believers to build themselves up on what?

Answer: B. Their most holy faith

Believers are told to build up themselves on their most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost. (Jude 1:20, KJV)

Q10. To whom does Jude attribute the ability to keep you from falling?

Answer: C. The only wise God our Saviour

The closing doxology praises Him who is able to keep you from falling. (Jude 1:24, KJV)
