Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. Of what tribe was Korah?

Answer: B. Levi

Numbers 16:1 (KJV) — 'Korah, the son of Izhar, the son of Kohath, the son of Levi.' (Numbers 16:1, KJV)

Q2. Who joined Korah in his rebellion?

Answer: A. Dathan and Abiram

Numbers 16:1 (KJV) names Dathan and Abiram with On. (Numbers 16:1, KJV)

Q3. How many princes of the assembly joined Korah?

Answer: B. 250

Numbers 16:2 (KJV) — 'two hundred and fifty princes of the assembly.' (Numbers 16:2, KJV)

Q4. Against whom did Korah rise up?

Answer: B. Moses and Aaron

Numbers 16:3 (KJV) — 'they gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron.' (Numbers 16:3, KJV)

Q5. What did Moses tell them to take in their hands?

Answer: B. Censers

Numbers 16:6 (KJV) — 'Take you censers, Korah, and all his company.' (Numbers 16:6, KJV)

Q6. How were Dathan and Abiram destroyed?

Answer: B. The earth opened and swallowed them

Numbers 16:32 (KJV) — 'The earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up.' (Numbers 16:32, KJV)

Q7. What consumed the 250 men offering incense?

Answer: B. Fire from the LORD

Numbers 16:35 (KJV) — 'there came out a fire from the LORD, and consumed the two hundred and fifty men.' (Numbers 16:35, KJV)

Q8. What was made of the censers afterward?

Answer: B. A covering for the altar

Numbers 16:38-39 (KJV) — they were made into broad plates for a covering of the altar. (Numbers 16:39, KJV)

Q9. How many died in the plague that followed?

Answer: C. 14,700

Numbers 16:49 (KJV) — 'they that died in the plague were fourteen thousand and seven hundred.' (Numbers 16:49, KJV)

Q10. Jude compares ungodly men to which rebellion?

Answer: D. All three

Jude 1:11 (KJV) — 'gone in the way of Cain... and perished in the gainsaying of Core.' (Jude 1:11, KJV)
