## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1.** In the first chapter, which brother did God say He loved, and which did He say He hated?

**Answer:** A. Loved Jacob, hated Esau

The Lord declares, 'I loved Jacob, and I hated Esau.' (Malachi 1:2, KJV)

**Q2.** What kind of bread did the priests offer upon God's altar that led to their rebuke?

**Answer:** B. Polluted bread

The priests are accused of offering 'polluted bread' upon the altar. (Malachi 1:7, KJV)

**Q3.** God states that His name shall be great among which group of people?

**Answer:** C. The Gentiles

God declares His name shall be great among the Gentiles from the rising of the sun. (Malachi 1:11, KJV)

**Q4.** With which tribe did God make a covenant of life and peace regarding the priesthood?

**Answer:** C. Levi

The Lord speaks of His covenant being with Levi for the fear wherewith he feared Him. (Malachi 2:4, KJV)

**Q5.** Complete the verse: 'For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth...'

**Answer:** B. Putting away

The KJV uses the term 'putting away' to refer to divorce. (Malachi 2:16, KJV)

**Q6.** Who does God say He will send to prepare the way before Him?

**Answer:** A. His messenger

The Lord says, 'Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me.' (Malachi 3:1, KJV)

**Q7.** Because the Lord does not change, what happens to the sons of Jacob?

**Answer:** B. They are not consumed

The Lord says, 'I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.' (Malachi 3:6, KJV)

**Q8.** In what two ways does God specifically say the people have robbed Him?

**Answer:** C. In tithes and offerings

God asks, 'Will a man rob God?' and specifies 'In tithes and offerings.' (Malachi 3:8, KJV)

**Q9.** What was written for them that feared the Lord and thought upon His name?

**Answer:** A. A book of remembrance

A book of remembrance was written before Him for them that feared the LORD. (Malachi 3:16, KJV)

**Q10.** Which prophet does God promise to send before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD?

**Answer:** C. Elijah

The final chapter promises, 'Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet.' (Malachi 4:5, KJV)
