2 Kings 21:1 (KJV) — 'twelve years old when he began to reign.' (2 Kings 21:1, KJV)

Q2. How long did Manasseh reign?

Answer: C. 55 years

2 Kings 21:1 (KJV) — 'fifty and five years in Jerusalem.' (2 Kings 21:1, KJV)

Q3. Whose son was Manasseh?

Answer: B. Hezekiah

2 Kings 20:21 (KJV) — 'Hezekiah slept with his fathers: and Manasseh his son reigned in his stead.' (2 Kings 20:21, KJV)

Q4. What did Manasseh build in the house of the LORD?

Answer: B. Altars for Baal and a grove

2 Kings 21:3 (KJV) — 'he reared up altars for Baal, and made a grove.' (2 Kings 21:3, KJV)

Q5. Which abomination did he do with his son?

Answer: B. Made him pass through the fire

2 Kings 21:6 (KJV) — 'made his son pass through the fire.' (2 Kings 21:6, KJV)

Q6. What did Manasseh shed in Jerusalem?

2 Kings 21:16 (KJV) — 'Manasseh shed innocent blood very much.' (2 Kings 21:16, KJV)

Q7. Who carried Manasseh away in chains?

2 Chronicles 33:11 (KJV) — 'the captains of the host of the king of Assyria.' (2 Chronicles 33:11, KJV)

Q8. To what city was Manasseh taken?

Answer: B. Babylon

2 Chronicles 33:11 (KJV) — 'carried him to Babylon.' (2 Chronicles 33:11, KJV)

Q9. What did Manasseh do in his affliction?

Answer: B. He humbled himself greatly and prayed

2 Chronicles 33:12 (KJV) — 'humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers.' (2 Chronicles 33:12, KJV)

Q10. Whose son succeeded Manasseh?

Answer: B. Amon

2 Kings 21:18 (KJV) — 'Amon his son reigned in his stead.' (2 Kings 21:18, KJV)
