And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him. (Genesis 2:18, KJV)

Q2. From what was the woman formed?

Answer: B. A rib taken from the man

And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. (Genesis 2:22, KJV)

Q3. What are husband and wife to become?

Answer: B. One flesh

Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh. (Genesis 2:24, KJV)

Q4. How are husbands commanded to love their wives?
