And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine. (Genesis 14:18, KJV)

Q3. Whose priest was Melchizedek?

Answer: B. Of the most high God

And he was the priest of the most high God. (Genesis 14:18, KJV)

Q4. What did Melchizedek do for Abram?

Answer: B. Blessed him

And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth. (Genesis 14:19, KJV)
