Q1. Whose son was Mephibosheth?

Answer: B. Jonathan

2 Samuel 4:4 (KJV) — 'Jonathan, Saul's son, had a son that was lame of his feet.' (2 Samuel 4:4, KJV)

Q2. How old was Mephibosheth when he became lame?

Answer: B. Five years

2 Samuel 4:4 (KJV) — 'He was five years old.' (2 Samuel 4:4, KJV)

Q3. How did Mephibosheth become lame?

Answer: B. His nurse dropped him as she fled

2 Samuel 4:4 (KJV) — 'As she made haste to flee... he fell, and became lame.' (2 Samuel 4:4, KJV)

Q4. Where was Mephibosheth dwelling when David sent for him?

Answer: B. Lo-debar

2 Samuel 9:4 (KJV) — 'He is in the house of Machir, the son of Ammiel, in Lo-debar.' (2 Samuel 9:4, KJV)

Q5. Who was the servant of Saul who served Mephibosheth?

Answer: B. Ziba

2 Samuel 9:2 (KJV) — 'There was of the house of Saul a servant whose name was Ziba.' (2 Samuel 9:2, KJV)

Q6. What did David restore to Mephibosheth?

Answer: B. All the land of Saul

2 Samuel 9:7 (KJV) — 'I will restore thee all the land of Saul thy father.' (2 Samuel 9:7, KJV)

Q7. Where did Mephibosheth eat continually?

Answer: B. At the king's table

2 Samuel 9:7 (KJV) — 'And thou shalt eat bread at my table continually.' (2 Samuel 9:7, KJV)

Q8. How did Mephibosheth describe himself before David?

Answer: B. A dead dog

2 Samuel 9:8 (KJV) — 'What is thy servant, that thou shouldest look upon such a dead dog as I am?' (2 Samuel 9:8, KJV)

Q9. What was the name of Mephibosheth's son?

Answer: A. Micha

2 Samuel 9:12 (KJV) — 'Mephibosheth had a young son, whose name was Micha.' (2 Samuel 9:12, KJV)

Q10. When David returned after Absalom's revolt, what had Mephibosheth not done?

Answer: B. Dressed his feet, trimmed his beard, or washed his clothes

2 Samuel 19:24 (KJV) — 'Had neither dressed his feet, nor trimmed his beard, nor washed his clothes.' (2 Samuel 19:24, KJV)
