Q1. What does Psalm 136 repeat in every verse?

Answer: B. For his mercy endureth for ever

O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever... repeated twenty-six times. (Psalms 136:1, KJV)

Q2. What did the publican say at the temple?

Answer: B. God be merciful to me a sinner

And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. (Luke 18:13, KJV)

Q3. What does Lamentations 3:22-23 say about God's mercies?

Answer: A. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness

It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness. (Lamentations 3:22, KJV)

Q4. What does Matthew 5:7 say about the merciful?
