Q1. How many loaves were used to feed the five thousand?

Answer: B. Five

We have here but five loaves, and two fishes. (Matthew 14:17, KJV)

Q2. How many fishes?

Answer: B. Two

Five loaves, and two fishes. (Matthew 14:17, KJV)

Q3. On what did Jesus command the multitude to sit?

Answer: B. The grass

He commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass. (Matthew 14:19, KJV)

Q4. How many baskets of fragments were taken up after the 5,000?

Answer: C. Twelve

They took up of the fragments that remained twelve baskets full. (Matthew 14:20, KJV)

Q5. Not counting women and children, how many men ate?

Answer: C. About five thousand

They that had eaten were about five thousand men, beside women and children. (Matthew 14:21, KJV)

Q6. Which boy brought the loaves and fishes?

Answer: A. A lad with five barley loaves and two small fishes

There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes. (John 6:9, KJV)

Q7. How many loaves at the feeding of the four thousand?

Answer: C. Seven

Seven, and a few little fishes. (Matthew 15:34, KJV)

Q8. How many baskets remained after the 4,000?

Answer: B. Seven

They took up of the broken meat that was left seven baskets full. (Matthew 15:37, KJV)

Q9. How long had the four thousand been with Jesus?

Answer: C. Three days

They continue with me now three days, and have nothing to eat. (Matthew 15:32, KJV)

Q10. What did Jesus first do before breaking the loaves?

Answer: B. Look up to heaven, and bless

Looking up to heaven, he blessed, and brake. (Matthew 14:19, KJV)
