## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1.** What did Israel murmur against Moses and Aaron for in the wilderness of Sin?

**Answer:** B. Hunger / flesh pots and bread

Would to God we had died by the hand of the LORD in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the flesh pots, and when we did eat bread to the full. (Exodus 16:3, KJV)

**Q2.** What did the LORD promise to rain from heaven?

**Answer:** B. Bread

I will rain bread from heaven for you. (Exodus 16:4, KJV)

**Q3.** What did the manna look like?

**Answer:** B. A small round thing, white, like coriander seed

It was like coriander seed, white; and the taste of it was like wafers made with honey. (Exodus 16:31, KJV)

**Q4.** How much manna was each person to gather?

**Answer:** A. One omer per person

This is the thing which the LORD hath commanded, Gather of it every man according to his eating, an omer for every man. (Exodus 16:16, KJV)

**Q5.** What happened to manna left until the morning?

**Answer:** A. It spoiled and bred worms

It bred worms, and stank. (Exodus 16:20, KJV)

**Q6.** How much extra could be gathered on the sixth day?

**Answer:** B. Twice as much

On the sixth day they gathered twice as much bread. (Exodus 16:22, KJV)

**Q7.** Why did the extra on the sixth day not spoil?

**Answer:** C. Both — it was the Sabbath portion

It did not stink, neither was there any worm therein... for to morrow is the rest of the holy sabbath unto the LORD. (Exodus 16:23, KJV)

**Q8.** What did Israel call the bread?

**Answer:** B. Manna

The house of Israel called the name thereof Manna. (Exodus 16:31, KJV)

**Q9.** What did God send in the evening alongside the manna?

**Answer:** B. Quails

At even the quails came up, and covered the camp. (Exodus 16:13, KJV)

**Q10.** How long did Israel eat manna?

**Answer:** B. Forty years, until they came to the borders of Canaan

The children of Israel did eat manna forty years, until they came to a land inhabited. (Exodus 16:35, KJV)
