Q1. Who led Israel against Jericho?

Answer: B. Joshua

Joshua the son of Nun called the priests. (Joshua 6:6, KJV)

Q2. Who appeared to Joshua near Jericho?

Answer: B. The captain of the host of the LORD

As captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. (Joshua 5:14, KJV)

Q3. How often were they to march around the city for six days?

Answer: A. Once

Ye shall compass the city, all ye men of war, and go round about the city once. (Joshua 6:3, KJV)

Q4. How many priests bore trumpets of rams' horns?

Answer: B. Seven

Seven priests shall bear before the ark seven trumpets of rams' horns. (Joshua 6:4, KJV)

Q5. How many times did they march on the seventh day?

Answer: C. Seven times

The seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times. (Joshua 6:4, KJV)

Q6. What was the people commanded to do at the great shout?

Answer: B. Shout with a great shout

All the people shall shout with a great shout. (Joshua 6:5, KJV)

Q7. What happened to the wall?

Answer: B. It fell down flat

The wall fell down flat. (Joshua 6:20, KJV)

Q8. Who was spared with her household?

Answer: B. Rahab the harlot

Joshua saved Rahab the harlot alive, and her father's household. (Joshua 6:25, KJV)

Q9. What sign marked Rahab's house?

Answer: B. A line of scarlet thread in the window

Thou shalt bind this line of scarlet thread in the window. (Joshua 2:18, KJV)

Q10. What curse did Joshua pronounce on whoever would rebuild Jericho?

Answer: B. It shall cost him his firstborn and his youngest

He shall lay the foundation thereof in his firstborn, and in his youngest son shall he set up the gates of it. (Joshua 6:26, KJV)
