Q1. Of what nation was Naaman captain?

Answer: B. Syria

2 Kings 5:1 (KJV) — 'Naaman, captain of the host of the king of Syria.' (2 Kings 5:1, KJV)

Q2. What disease afflicted Naaman?

Answer: B. Leprosy

2 Kings 5:1 (KJV) — 'But he was a leper.' (2 Kings 5:1, KJV)

Q3. Who told Naaman's wife about the prophet in Samaria?

Answer: B. A little maid from Israel

2 Kings 5:2-3 (KJV) — 'A little maid... said... Would God my lord were with the prophet that is in Samaria.' (2 Kings 5:3, KJV)

Q4. Which prophet healed Naaman?

Answer: B. Elisha

2 Kings 5:8 (KJV) — Elisha said, 'Let him come now to me, and he shall know that there is a prophet in Israel.' (2 Kings 5:8, KJV)

Q5. How many times was Naaman told to dip in Jordan?

Answer: C. Seven

2 Kings 5:10 (KJV) — 'Go and wash in Jordan seven times.' (2 Kings 5:10, KJV)

Q6. Which two rivers did Naaman prefer to Jordan?

Answer: B. Abana and Pharpar

2 Kings 5:12 (KJV) — 'Are not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel?' (2 Kings 5:12, KJV)

2 Kings 5:14 (KJV) — 'His flesh came again like unto the flesh of a little child.' (2 Kings 5:14, KJV)

2 Kings 5:16 (KJV) — 'As the LORD liveth... I will receive none.' (2 Kings 5:16, KJV)

Q9. Who pursued Naaman to take a gift secretly?

2 Kings 5:20-21 (KJV) — 'Gehazi... ran after Naaman.' (2 Kings 5:21, KJV)

Q10. Who mentioned Naaman in His sermon at Nazareth?

Answer: C. Jesus

Luke 4:27 (KJV) — 'None of them was cleansed, saving Naaman the Syrian.' (Luke 4:27, KJV)
