Q1. What was Naomi's husband's name?

Answer: A. Elimelech

And the name of the man was Elimelech, and the name of his wife Naomi. (Ruth 1:2, KJV)

Q2. Why did Naomi's family leave Bethlehem?

Answer: A. A famine

And there was a famine in the land. And a certain man of Bethlehemjudah went to sojourn in the country of Moab. (Ruth 1:1, KJV)

Q3. Where did Naomi's family go to live?

Answer: A. Moab

He, and his wife, and his two sons... And they came into the country of Moab, and continued there. (Ruth 1:2, KJV)

Q4. Who were Naomi's two daughters in law?

Answer: A. Orpah and Ruth

And they took them wives of the women of Moab; the name of the one was Orpah, and the name of the other Ruth. (Ruth 1:4, KJV)

Q5. What did Naomi tell her daughters in law to do?

Answer: A. Return each to her mother's house

And Naomi said unto her two daughters in law, Go, return each to her mother's house: the LORD deal kindly with you. (Ruth 1:8, KJV)

Q6. What name did Naomi ask to be called?

Answer: A. Mara, for the Almighty hath dealt very bitterly with me

Call me not Naomi, call me Mara: for the Almighty hath dealt very bitterly with me. (Ruth 1:20, KJV)

Q7. What does the name Naomi mean (per her own contrast)?

Call me not Naomi (pleasant), call me Mara (bitter): for the Almighty hath dealt very bitterly with me. (Ruth 1:20, KJV)

Q8. When did Naomi return to Bethlehem?

Answer: A. At the beginning of barley harvest

So Naomi returned, and Ruth the Moabitess, her daughter in law... they came to Bethlehem in the beginning of barley harvest. (Ruth 1:22, KJV)

Q9. Whose field did Naomi tell Ruth to visit?

Answer: A. Boaz, a near kinsman

And Naomi had a kinsman of her husband's, a mighty man of wealth, of the family of Elimelech; and his name was Boaz. (Ruth 2:1, KJV)

Q10. What did the women say of Obed concerning Naomi?

Answer: A. There is a son born to Naomi

And the women her neighbours gave it a name, saying, There is a son born to Naomi; and they called his name Obed. (Ruth 4:17, KJV)
