Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. What nation did Nebuchadnezzar rule?

Answer: B. Babylon

Daniel 1:1 (KJV) — 'Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came unto Jerusalem, and besieged it.' (Daniel 1:1, KJV)

Q2. What young Hebrews did Nebuchadnezzar train in his court?

Answer: B. Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah

Daniel 1:6-7 (KJV) — Among the children of Judah were Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, whom the prince of the eunuchs renamed. (Daniel 1:6, KJV)

Q3. What did Nebuchadnezzar dream that none of his wise men could interpret?

Answer: B. A great image of various metals

Daniel 2:31 (KJV) — Nebuchadnezzar saw 'a great image... whose brightness was excellent,' with head of gold, chest of silver, etc. (Daniel 2:31, KJV)

Q4. What did Daniel say the head of gold in the dream represented?

Answer: B. Babylon / Nebuchadnezzar

Daniel 2:37-38 (KJV) — Daniel told him, 'Thou, O king, art a king of kings: for the God of heaven hath given thee a kingdom... thou art this head of gold.' (Daniel 2:38, KJV)

Q5. What did Nebuchadnezzar build on the plain of Dura?

Answer: B. A golden image

Daniel 3:1 (KJV) — 'Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold, whose height was threescore cubits, and the breadth thereof six cubits.' (Daniel 3:1, KJV)

Q6. What punishment did Nebuchadnezzar decree for not worshipping the image?

Answer: B. The fiery furnace

Daniel 3:6 (KJV) — 'Whoso falleth not down and worshippeth shall the same hour be cast into the midst of a burning fiery furnace.' (Daniel 3:6, KJV)

Q7. In his second dream, what grew to heaven and was hewn down?

Answer: B. A great tree

Daniel 4:10-14 (KJV) — Nebuchadnezzar saw a tree whose height reached heaven, and a watcher commanded it be hewn down. (Daniel 4:10, KJV)

Q8. How long was Nebuchadnezzar driven from men to eat grass like oxen?

Answer: B. Seven times (years)

Daniel 4:32 (KJV) — 'They shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field... till thou know that the most High ruleth.' (Daniel 4:32, KJV)

Q9. What did Nebuchadnezzar say when his reason returned?

Answer: B. I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured him

Daniel 4:34 (KJV) — 'I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the most High...' (Daniel 4:34, KJV)

Q10. Whose sons were put in charge of the affairs of the province of Babylon?

Answer: B. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego

Daniel 2:49 (KJV) — 'Then Daniel requested of the king, and he set Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, over the affairs of the province of Babylon.' (Daniel 2:49, KJV)
