Q1. What was Nicodemus' position?

Answer: B. A Pharisee, a ruler of the Jews

There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. (John 3:1, KJV)

Q2. When did Nicodemus come to Jesus?

Answer: B. By night

The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God. (John 3:2, KJV)

Q3. What did Nicodemus call Jesus?

Answer: B. Rabbi, a teacher come from God

Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him. (John 3:2, KJV)

Q4. What did Jesus tell Nicodemus a man must be to see the kingdom of God?

Answer: A. Born of water and of the Spirit

Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God... Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. (John 3:3, KJV)

Q5. What did Jesus compare the wind to?

Answer: B. The Spirit blowing where it listeth

The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit. (John 3:8, KJV)

Q6. What did Jesus reference to explain the new birth?

Answer: B. Moses lifting up the serpent in the wilderness

And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up. (John 3:14, KJV)

Q7. What famous verse did Jesus speak to Nicodemus?

Answer: B. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16, KJV)

Q8. What did Nicodemus say to the Pharisees about Jesus?

Answer: A. Doth our law judge any man, before it hear him, and know what he doeth?

Nicodemus saith unto them, (He that came to Jesus by night, being one of them,) Doth our law judge any man, before it hear him, and know what he doeth? (John 7:51, KJV)

Q9. What did Nicodemus bring for Jesus' burial?

Answer: B. A mixture of myrrh and aloes, about an hundred pound weight

And there came also Nicodemus, which at the first came to Jesus by night, and brought a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about an hundred pound weight. (John 19:39, KJV)

Q10. How is Nicodemus' later openness a testimony?

Answer: B. He moved from night to daylight — defending Jesus before the Sanhedrin and honouring Him in burial

Nicodemus progressed from a secret night visitor to a public defender and faithful servant at Jesus' burial. (John 19:39, KJV)
