Answer: A. He began to be a mighty one in the earth

He began to be a mighty one in the earth. (Genesis 10:8) (Genesis 10:8, KJV)

Q3. What was Nimrod before the LORD?

Answer: A. A mighty hunter

He was a mighty hunter before the LORD: wherefore it is said, Even as Nimrod the mighty hunter before the LORD. (Genesis 10:9) (Genesis 10:9, KJV)

Q4. Where did the kingdom of Nimrod begin?

Answer: A. Babel, and Erech, and Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar

And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, and Erech, and Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar. (Genesis 10:10) (Genesis 10:10, KJV)

Q8. What does 'before the LORD' likely mean in Nimrod's description?

The phrase 'a mighty hunter before the LORD' likely carries the sense of defiance or opposition to the LORD, as Nimrod's later building of Babel demonstrates rebellion against God. (Genesis 10:9; 11:4) (Genesis 10:9, KJV)

Q9. What does Genesis 11:4 say the people of Babel wanted to build?

Answer: A. A city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven

And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth. (Genesis 11:4) (Genesis 11:4, KJV)

Q10. What was God's response to the tower of Babel?

Answer: A. He confounded their language and scattered them abroad upon the face of all the earth

So the LORD scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city. Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the LORD did there confound the language of all the earth. (Genesis 11:8-9) (Genesis 11:8, KJV)

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
