## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1. Who was the first man created by God?**

**Answer: A. Adam**

And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground. (Genesis 2:7, KJV)

**Q2. How many days and nights did it rain during the Flood?**

**Answer: C. 40**

And the rain was upon the earth forty days and forty nights. (Genesis 7:12, KJV)

**Q3. Who led the Israelites out of Egypt?**

**Answer: C. Moses**

Moses was commissioned by God at the burning bush to bring Israel out of bondage. (Exodus 3, KJV)

**Q4. On which mountain did Moses receive the Ten Commandments?**

**Answer: A. Mount Sinai**

And Moses went up unto God upon mount Sinai. (Exodus 19:3, KJV)

**Q5. Who defeated Goliath with a sling and a stone?**

**Answer: C. David**

So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and with a stone. (1 Samuel 17:50, KJV)

**Q6. Which prophet was taken up to heaven in a whirlwind?**

**Answer: B. Elijah**

Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven. (2 Kings 2:11, KJV)

**Q7. Who interpreted Pharaoh's dreams of seven cows and seven ears of corn?**

**Answer: B. Joseph**

Joseph interpreted the dreams as seven years of plenty followed by seven years of famine. (Genesis 41, KJV)

**Q8. Who was swallowed by a great fish?**

**Answer: A. Jonah**

Now the LORD had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. (Jonah 1:17, KJV)

**Q9. How many books are in the Old Testament (KJV)?**

**Answer: B. 39**

The Protestant Old Testament contains 39 books, from Genesis to Malachi.

**Q10. Which book begins, 'In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth'?**

**Answer: C. Genesis**

Genesis 1:1 is the opening verse of the Bible. (Genesis 1:1, KJV)
