Philemon 1:10-11 (KJV) — Paul writes to Philemon concerning Onesimus. (Philemon 1:10, KJV)

Q2. Who wrote the epistle of Philemon?

Answer: B. Paul

Philemon 1:1 (KJV) — 'Paul, a prisoner of Jesus Christ.' (Philemon 1:1, KJV)

Q3. Where was Paul when he begat Onesimus in the faith?

Answer: B. In his bonds

Philemon 1:10 (KJV) — 'whom I have begotten in my bonds.' (Philemon 1:10, KJV)

Q4. What did the name Onesimus mean for Paul's argument?

Answer: B. Profitable

Philemon 1:11 (KJV) — 'now profitable to thee and to me.' (Philemon 1:11, KJV)
